Dr. Panagiotis Avramidis teaches quantitative tools in finance, business statistics, risk management and banking regulation. Currently, his research includes empirical studies in finance and management and particularly in the area of financial intermediation, risk and managerial decision making.

His research work has been published in scientific journals, including Management Science, Harvard Business Review, Journal of Financial Intermediation, Journal of Banking and Finance, Journal of Financial Stability, Journal of Marketing, Journal of the Academy of Marketing Science, Journal of Non-parametric statistics and Statistica Sinica. In addition, he writes regularly in daily press. In the past, Dr Avramidis has delivered tutorial courses and workshops at the London School of Economics and at the London Business School. He has held a senior position at Fitch Risk, (a consultancy subsidiary of Fitch Ratings) and a senior manager position at ICAP Group's Credit Risk Services.
